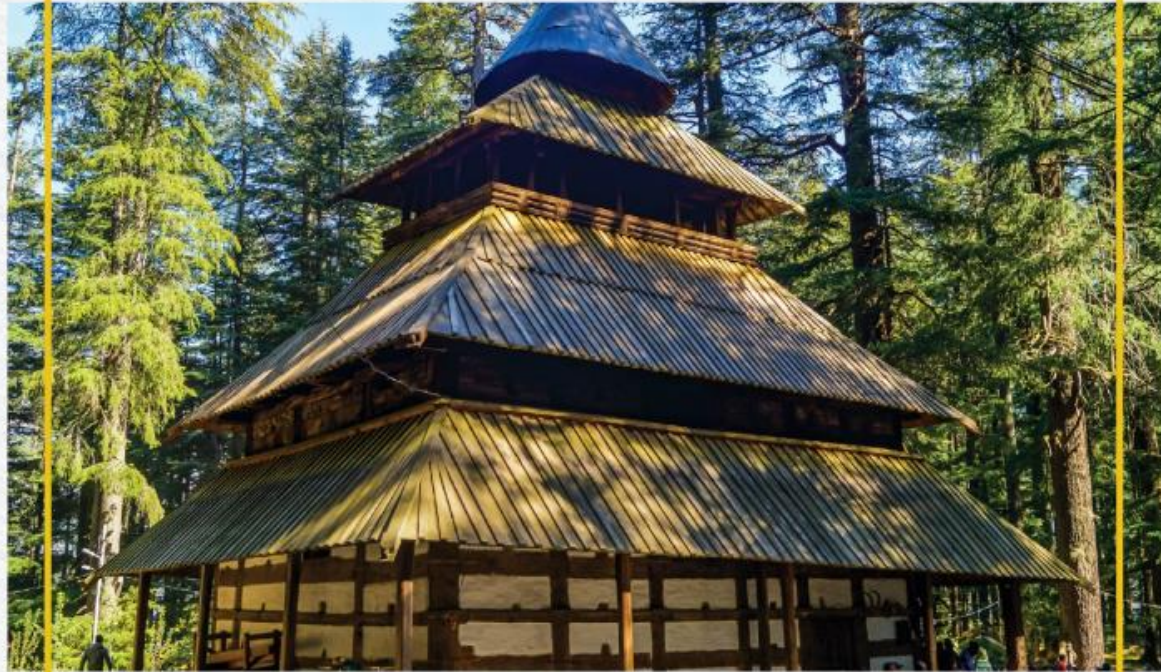

DAY 1

MANALI LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

- Leave from Delhi at 06:30 P.M. (Day 0) and reach Manali next morning.
- Check in to the hotel, freshen up & relax.
- Post breakfast head for local sightseeing of Manali.
- Places to Visit – Hidimba Temple, Jogni Waterfall, Vashisht Temple, Mall Road.
- Old Manali Cafe Crawl, Collect your bikes & come back to the hotel by evening.
- Dinner followed by a briefing for the next day & overnight sleep.



DAY 2

MANALI TO SARCHU

- Wake up early morning, check out from the hotel.
- Start your ride on the famous Leh-Manali Highway.
- Drive through Atal Tunnel to Lahaul Valley, along the Chandra river to Keylong, the district headquarters of Lahaul & Spiti.
- Visit Suraj Tal, a small lake on the top of Baralacha-La and enjoy the panoramic views.
- Arrive at Sarchu. Overnight stay in camps under million stars.



DAY 3

GATA LOOPS-LACHUNG LA-TANGLANG LA-LEH

- After breakfast at the campsite, head to Leh.
- En Route, cross the Gata Loops (21 hairpin bends) at 4669 m, Nakee-La (4739 m) and then Lachung-La (5065m) just above Brandy bridge.
- Reach Pang(an army base at 4600m) by afternoon and have lunch at Pang.
- Drive through the beautiful Moore Plains & after crossing Tanglang-La (5328 m), continue your journey through Upshi, Karu and then finally Leh.
- Check-in to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.



DAY 4

LEH LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

- Wake Up & have breakfast at the hotel.
- Post breakfast head for the local sightseeing of Leh.
- Places to Visit – Hall of Fame, Shanti Stupa, Magnetic hills and Pathar Sahib Gurudwara
- Evening free for leisure and acclimatization.
- Explore the local Leh Market and some cafes around.
- Come back to the hotel by evening.
- Dinner & sleep overnight.



DAY 5

KHARDUNG LA - HUNDAR - NUBRA VALLEY - DISKIT

- After breakfast, head for beautiful Nubra Valley via Khardung La (Highest motorable road at 5359 mt).
- You'll find yourself surrounded between the Karakoram and Ladakh ranges of the Himalayas.
- Check in to the hotel and visit the Sand Dunes (cold deserts of India), take a camel safari (self-paid).
- Visit the Diskit village and the Monastery around.
- Come back to the hotel by evening, dinner and sleep overnight.



DAY 6

SHYOK - PANGONG TSO LAKE

- After breakfast check out, start your journey to the famous Pangong Tso via the Agam and Shyok villages.
- Pangong Tso changes its color 4-5 times a day & with a backdrop of mountains of various hues & colors, it is sight for the Gods.
- Reach Pangong Lake & check in to the campsite.
- Dinner & sleep overnight.



DAY 7

CHANG LA - LEH

- Wake up early morning to witness a mesmerizing sunrise.
- After having breakfast, head back to Leh Via Chang-La (Second Highest motorable road at 5350 mt).
- Reach by evening time and explore the local market/cafes in leh.
- Come back to the hotel by evening.
- Dinner and sleep overnight.



DAY 8

LEH - JISPA

- Wake up & post breakfast bid farewell to the Leh city.
- Depart for Manali.
- Overnight halt at Jispa.
- Reach Jispa & check in to the camps.



DAY 9

JISPA - MANALI DEPARTURE

- Wake up early morning & post breakfast depart for Manali.
- Reach Manali & depart for Delhi by evening.
- Reach Delhi by morning with amazing trip memories.

INCLUSIONS

- ✓ Volvo transfer from Delhi to Manali & back.
- ✓ Bike Rent for 8 days (For Biking Option).
- ✓ Fuel for the bike(Manali to Manali).
- ✓ Entire travel from Manali to Manali by tempo traveler/cab (For Tempo Traveler Option).
- ✓ Stay for 8 nights – 1 night in a hotel at Manali, 1 night in camps at Sarchu. 3 nights in a hotel at Leh, 1 night in a hotel at Hundar, 1 night in camps at Pangong Tso & 1 night in camps at Jispa on triple/quad sharing basis.
- ✓ A total of 15 meals – 1 meal Day 1 (B) + 1 meal Day 2 (D) + 2 meals Day 3 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 4 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 5 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 6 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 7 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 8 (B+D) + 1 meal Day 9 (B)
- ✓ Mechanical Backup.
- ✓ All inner line permits for the trip.
- ✓ Driver Night Charges, Toll Tax, Parking Charges, etc.
- ✓ Team Captain throughout the trip.
- ✓ An Oxygen Cylinder 24X7 in the car in case of emergency.



EXCLUSIONS

- ✘ GST (5%) is applicable extra.
- ✘ Any kind of food or beverage that is not included in the package like alcoholic drinks, mineral water, meals/refreshments/lunches on the highway.
- ✘ Any personal expenses like a tip to the drivers, entry to monuments/monasteries, camera/video camera charges, camel safari, river rafting, laundry, telephone bills, tips, etc.
- ✘ Any cost arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks etc. (to be borne directly by the customer on the spot).
- ✘ Anything not mentioned in the inclusions.
- ✘ Any damage to the bike except engine damage must be borne by the client.

- Travellers residing outside Delhi are suggested to book trains/flights reaching Delhi not later than 2 PM on the trip start date. Similarly, on trip end date, book returning flight/trains leaving post 4 PM.
- Numerous factors such as weather, road conditions, the physical ability of participants etc. may cause itinerary change. We reserve the rights to change any schedule in the interest of safety, comfort and general wellbeing.
- INR 10,000/- needs to be submitted as security for the bike before the start of the trip. Any damage to the bike, except engine damage, has to be borne directly by the client.
- All the riders are required to wear a riding jacket (won't be provided by us) at all the times they are riding the bike, else won't be allowed to ride the bike.
